What are the Requirements?

Senior matriculation (grade 12) completed;
B.A. or equivalent if trainee seeking a Professional Certificate Level II from TESL Canada Federation.

Notification to applicants without an undergraduate degree:

Canada College TESOL Program accepts trainees without an undergraduate degree. It should be noted, however, that these graduates will not qualify for the TESL Canada professional certification.

How to apply?

We have rolling admissions, so we encourage you to apply as soon as you can.

- If you are an international student requiring a visa, you should submit your application and all supporting documents as soon as possible so that to have sufficient time to process your visa request.

Transcripts

Official copies of your high school / university transcripts should be sent directly to the Admission Office.

We are happy to accept unofficial copies of your transcripts attached to your application pending the receipt of official documents.

Payment

A non-refundable \$100.00 fee should accompany your application.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT INFORMATION

Applying for a Student Visa

Apply directly through the Diploma Program. Complete the Application for your CAQ and mail with all supporting documentation. Visa processing takes several weeks, so we suggest you apply to the program at least 6 months before the program starts. When you receive the acceptance letter from us and a positive respond from Quebec Immigration, you will then apply for your Student Authorization by submitting your application to the nearest Canadian Embassy in your country.

Notice that since this is a short program, you do not need a CAQ and a student visa. You may come to Canada on a visiting visa. But if your English proficiency is not at the level to enroll in the TESOL Diploma program, you may take certain English courses prior to register in the TESOL Diploma Program.

International students, who are registered and paid their tuition fees, are eligible for the following **free services**:

- Airport Pickup
- Help in finding a suitable lodging
- Help with finding a best medical insurance
- Help to extend your visa
- Help in finding good and affordable city and country tours
- Help to visit clinics or hospitals
- Free Wireless Internet in campus

PROOF OF ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

All non-native speakers of English, including those who have an undergraduate degree from an English-medium university in Canada, the U.S. or abroad, must submit either:

- A minimum score of 550/213/80 on the TOEFL, 5 TWE and 60 TSE

- A score of 85 on MELAB and 4 on the speaking test
- A score of 5 for listening, reading and writing and a score of 4.5 for speaking on the CAN Test
- A score of 6.5 or better on the IELTS
- A band 60 overall score with a minimum of 60 in each of the writing and speaking subtests on the CAEL

Since it can take several weeks for TOEFL to send your score to us and we cannot accept you without the required proof of English proficiency, **we suggest you:** Take the test as soon as possible, and send us an unofficial photocopy of your score with your application (or shortly thereafter). We will begin processing your application with your unofficial score while we wait for your official score.



TESOL DIPLOMA

Note: Students who have already successfully completed a TESL Canada recognized certification may transfer their credits into our TESOL Diploma program. Canada College's students with a TESOL certificate will be granted admission into our diploma program. These students will only do the remaining courses.
