







INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Pre-Installation Guidelines

All In Ground fixtures should be installed so that water will be able to drain away from the fixture. We recommend using pea gravel or sand as this will allow for superior drainage.


1 DIG HOLE



Dig hole approximately 1 ft. in diameter by 1 ft. deep.


Leave approximately 4 in. surrounding the fixture for sand or pea gravel.

2 WIRE CONNECTION



Install your lead wire from fixture to your low voltage wire using silicone filled wire connectors.

3 FILL HOLE



Fill hole with pea gravel or sand.

Adjust the fixture so that the top edge is above the grade by 1".

Install LED lamp inside fixture. (Adjust gimble ring to desired angle)

Secure cover (if using one)

For optimum performance: Do not cover or surround well light with any leaves, mulch, bark or other material that could cause a fire or damage the lens.
