You can adjust Colour Temperature, Contrast, Brightness, Colour and Sharpness to the levels you prefer.

- 1. Press the MENU button to select Main Menu.

- 3. Press the **PR**▲/**PR**▼ button to select **Color Temperature**.

Contrast

This function is to adjust picture to light/dark.

Brightness

This function is to adjust brightness of picture.

Colour

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This function is to adjust intensity of the colour.

Sharpness

Adjust to sharpen or soften the picture.



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- Special Function Controls

N.R.(Noise Reduction)

The **N.R.** feature improves the picture quality by setting to **Mode1** or **Mode2**. If you experience noise on a certain programme, set the N.R. to **Mode1** or **Mode2** for this to obtain the optimum picture.

- 1. Press the MENU button to select Main Menu.
- 2. Press the **PR**▲/**P**R▼ button to select **Special**.
- 3. Press the **PR**▲/**P**R▼ button to select **N.R.**.
- 4. Press the ◀ / ► button to enter Off, Mode1 or Mode2.
- 5. Press the **MENU** button to return to the prior menu.



Blue Back

If no signal is being received or the signal is very weak, a blue screen automatically replaces the noisy picture background.

If you wish to continue viewing the poor picture, you must select the Blue Back Off.

(Pressing the ◀ / ► button will alternate between "On" and "Off".)

- 1. Press the **MENU** button to select **Main Menu**.
- 2. Press the **PR**▲/**PR**▼ button to select **Special**.

Reset

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This function allows you to return to the good picture reproduction programmed at the factory and cannot be changed.

- 1. Press the MENU button to select Main Menu.
- 2. Press the PR▲/PR▼ button to select Setup.
- 3. Press the PR▲/PR▼ button to select Reset
- 4. Press the ◀ / ► button to reset.
- 5. Press the **MENU** button to return to the prior menu.
