



FABRIC WARRANTY

WHO THIS WARRANTY PROTECTS	This warranty protects the original purchaser of Sunbrella fabric.
WHAT THIS WARRANTY PROTECTS AGAINST	This warranty protects against Sunbrella fabric becoming unserviceable due to color or strength loss from normal usage and exposure conditions, including sunlight, mildew and atmospheric chemicals.
WHAT THIS WARRANTY COVERS	This warranty covers Sunbrella fabric only.
WHAT THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER	This warranty does not cover normal care and cleaning; damage from misuse or abuse; improper installation; or costs associated with replacement of the fabric, including labor and installation.
LIMITS TO THE WARRANTY	Glen Raven's liability is expressly limited to this warranty. Glen Raven reserves the right to inspect the fabric submitted for claim.
WHAT WE WILL DO	Glen Raven will supply new equivalent fabric to replace the fabric that becomes unserviceable.
WHO TO CONTACT	Contact your Glen Raven sales or customer service representative for warranty claims.
WHO CONSUMERS SHOULD CONTACT	Sunbrella is normally a component of an end product such as an awning, umbrella or cushion. Consumers and end-users should contact the fabricator, dealer or retailer from whom you purchased the end product.
WARRANTY COVERAGE PERIOD	Performance improvements introduced November 1, 2008 allowed Glen Raven to increase the warranty period for Sunbrella fabrics. See below for details.

WARRANTY COVERAGE PERIOD

SUNBRELLA AWNING AND MARINE CANVAS

For installations prior to November 1, 2008, the warranty coverage period is five years from the original purchase date.

For installations on or after November 1, 2008, the warranty coverage period is ten years from the original purchase date. Glen Raven will provide replacement fabric at no cost during years one through eight; at the then-current selling price less a 30% discount during the ninth year; and less a 15% discount during the tenth year.

SUNBRELLA FURNITURE FABRICS AND ALL OTHER SUNBRELLA FABRICS

This coverage applies to all Sunbrella furniture fabrics, window treatment fabrics, and specialty fabrics such as Sunbrella Plus, Sunbrella Supreme, and Sunbrella View. The Sunbrella Graphics System is covered under a separate warranty.

For installations prior to November 1, 2008, the warranty coverage period is three years from the original purchase date.

For installations on or after November 1, 2008, the warranty coverage period is five years from the original purchase date.

Proper Care & Maintenance for (HDPE) Poly Furniture

Poly furniture is made from High Density Polyethylene (HDPE), a recyclable plastic that will never need to be painted or stained. It will not rot or splinter, and it contains an added UV protective agent to resist fading. Poly furniture is not affected by most corrosive substances, and will not promote bacterial growth.

To maintain the beauty of your furniture, clean it regularly with soap and water. Use only nonabrasive soaps. While most colors need to be cleaned only several times per year using soap and water, certain colors such as White, (but not limited to this color) need to be cleaned frequently in order to maintain its original beauty. In extreme situations and with colors such as White, spray the furniture thoroughly with a nonabrasive cleaner then scrub the furniture using a soft bristle brush and rinse it off with warm clean water. If needed spray the furniture with nonabrasive cleaner and wash it using a high pressure washer. Do not place the tip of your pressure washer closer than 8"-12" from the furniture or it will tear into the material.

Do not place flower pots or any items on furniture that will leave stains. Do not place hot items directly onto furniture to avoid melting.

All fasteners on furniture manufactured by Berlin Gardens are stainless steel with most fasteners being *Allochromed Stainless Steel*. *Allochromed Stainless Steel* is a coated stainless steel and one of the most corrosive resistant fasteners on the market. However, in extreme conditions such as coastal areas, while *Allochrome Stainless Steel* will be less likely to rust, it is still recommended to regularly rinse it with fresh water to ensure the longevity of your furniture and fasteners.

If properly cared for, you will be able to relax in your fine piece of poly furniture for many years!
